



When renting a golf cart from DOWNTOWN CART RENTALS, you are accepting all the terms of the RENTAL AGREEMENT & WAIVER. A copy will be or has been sent the email that you have provided. **A summary of the terms of the RENTAL AGREEMENT & WAIVER are as follows:**

- Responsible party **must be 21+ years old to rent**; assigned drivers must **18+ years old to drive**. **Responsible party accepts all financial responsibility for any/all damage.**
- **The golf carts are to be driven just as you would drive a regular vehicle.** All speed limits, traffic signs and laws must be obeyed. This means you can get pulled over and can be issued citations, even a DUI.
- **All golf carts must remain only on paved, public roads.** Do not drive on or park on the sand, sidewalks, water, piers, etc. Driving on the beaches or private property is strictly prohibited.
- **All passengers MUST wear seatbelts at all times.** Regardless of age, seatbelts cannot be shared. Small children must be in car seat or booster seat, if required by law in regular vehicle. **No more than 4 passengers in a 4-seater cart and no more than 6 passengers in a 6-seater.** Refusal to follow these rules can result in the confiscation of cart(s).
- **Rented golf carts must remain within the mapped area.** Stay South of Hwy 90 and no further East of Holcomb Blvd. A map of the riding area is located in the brochure provided as well as on our website. **A minimum of \$75 charge, if golf carts go outside of this boundary.** **THE CARTS ARE GPS MONITORED!**
- **If carts are being misused, they will be confiscated and no refunds will be issued.**
- **If carts are returned late, the responsible party will be charged \$25 per every 15 mins late.** **Cleaning &/ or damage fees may also be applied if not returned in the same condition.**

If there is an accident or if the cart breaks down, do not push, tow or move the vehicle. In the event of accident, call 911 first. Then, call us at 228-300-2278 immediately.



GOLF CART OPERATING PROCEDURES

- Turn key to the ON position to begin. When you leave the vehicle, turn the key to the OFF position and remove the key from the vehicle.
- Make sure the direction selector is in the correct position before you press the accelerator pedal. Directional selector is located below front seat.
- Make sure you completely stop vehicle before moving the direction selector.
- Before you drive in the reverse direction, make sure the area behind the vehicle is clear.
- **All passengers MUST wear seatbelts at all times. Small children MUST be in carseat or booster seat.**
- Always keep feet, legs, hands and arms inside the vehicle.
- **Only travel on roads marked 30 mph or less and only in areas outlined on the map provided.**
Do NOT cross Hwy 90 or go further East than Holcomb Blvd.
- Do not drive on rough terrain.
- Decrease speed before and during turns.
- Do not drive fast downhill. Sudden stops or change of direction can cause loss of control. Use the brake to control the speed of the vehicle when driving down a slope.
- Abide all traffic laws. You can get pulled over by police and may be issued citation(s).
- Use headlights during night-time travel only.
- Carts are not to be towed or tow any other vehicles for any reason.
- Please return cart(s) clean and on time to avoid any additional fees.
- To connect to the Bluetooth radio, select "SPK-8635-C". No password required.

If involved in an accident OR golf cart breaks down for ANY reason,
